## 2. SAPS FEEDBACK

We currently have a serious problem with **theft out of motor vehicles**

Suspects usually will park next to you or are already parked when the victim arrives.

Victim will then get out of vehicle and lock the vehicle without physically checking if the vehicle is locked. Suspects would have, by this time, opened a door on the passenger side, and that action would allow the vehicle to properly lock. Mostly laptops are stolen from the vehicles.

- Before you depart to work or gym, put anything valuable inside your vehicle's boot.
- When you park or stop at a filling station, make sure your vehicle is locked by physically pulling on the door handle.

Let's try to curb this crime trend currently by patrolling businesses, especially fuel garages, during peak times in the morning and afternoon.

## 6. CRIME FEEDBACK

### Silverton

On **7/7/2026 at 12h30** an armed robbery took place at Silver Mall. A shootout occurred between suspects and security personnel. One individual was injured but received medical treatment.

On **Saturday 11/7/2026 at 08h57** Extra Secure response officer informed control that at the corner of Moreleta and Roberts Street, there were two individuals being violent (threatening with a knife), and suspected that they were in possession of illegal substances. SAPS was dispatched to the scene. SAPS searched the suspects. One of the suspects did have illegal substances on him. He was arrested.

On **16/7/2026** at midday, Extra Secure was dispatched to the area of President Street regarding 3 x male suspects that had been spotted carrying a bag that as if it contained a rifle. Extra Secure patrolled the area thoroughly and spotted the suspects trying to flee into the bushes. The officers reacted swiftly, and the suspects were quickly apprehended at the corner of Joseph Bosman and Smarag Street. Security officers searched the suspects and the contents of the bag they were carrying; they were found to have illegal substances on them. The bag contained crowbars, plugs that had been removed from walls, cables, and spanners. SAPS was immediately dispatched. SAPS confirmed that the suspects are linked to other crimes, including house breakings. An official case has been opened against the suspects
