5. CRIME ACTIVITIES IN SILVERTON AND WEAVIND PARK

Several incidents of tampering with gate motors in the Silverton and Weavind Park area during June 2026

On 10 June 2026 at 17:30, the vehicle owner parked his Toyota Etios at Silver Mall. When the owner returned at 18:05 to his vehicle, he discovered that his vehicle had been stolen. **(Zone 4)**

On 13 June 2026 at 2:00 in the morning, the Extra Secure control room was notified about a fire in Krige Street. Sierra 1 and Delta 1 assisted at the scene where the fire occurred. Control arranged for the fire department to assist. **(Zone 5)**

On 18 June 2026, a suspect tried to enter a property, to cut cable/electrical wires. The suspect had a bag with him containing tools for breaking in. Extra Secure was on the scene.

On 18 June 2026 at 10:30, an armed robbery at gunpoint took place at a Spaza shop in Jasmyn Street. **(Zone 6)**

On 20 June 2026, a suspect broke a meter box that had been mounted into a fence at 1 of the property in Jasmyn ave.

On 24 June 2026 at 14h57, a group message on WhatsApp was received that 2 individuals were busy extracting wires and other goods at the corner of Matcham and Moreleta Street from the railway. Extra Secure response team was dispatched to the scene and apprehended the suspects; confirmation was received that the goods did not belong to the suspects. SAPS were on the scene to take the 2 suspects into custody. **(Zone 6)**

During the early morning hours of Monday 29 June 2026, Extra Secure control room received a panic alarm from a client's premises. Theft and vandalism. Suspects stole an air conditioning box wiring and other goods. Suspects were detained and apprehended by response and SAPS.

At 14h57, a cell phone theft and recovery at Wimpy Silver Water Crossings. Suspect where taken into custody.

A lot of crime activities took place in the East Ridge during June 2036.

10. **RECEIPE FOR THE MONTH**

Bundt Orange/Lemon Cake in Air Fryer

3 Eggs
250ml Sugar
200ml Milk
100g Butter
375ml Self Raising Flour
Pinch of Salt
10ml Orange/Lemon zest

Grease a Bundt tin that will fit into your air fryer.

Whisk the egg and sugar together until light and creamy.

Melt the butter and milk in a microwavable dish, do not boil the butter, the butter must just melt.

Sieve the flour and salt over the egg-mixture add the orange zest, milk and butter mixture. Mix until combined. Pour into the prepared Bundt tin and bake for 22-30 minutes at 180°C in your air fryer

In the meantime, place all the sauce ingredients into a microwavable dish and microwave until sugar has dissolved. Remove the cake from the tin when done and pour the warm sauce over the warm cake

For the Sauce

250ml Orange Juice/80ml Lemon juice + 125ml Water

160ml Sugar

15ml Butter

5ml Orange/Lemon Zest
