#### 4. FEEDBACK FROM THE COMMUNITY

One of the residents in Graniet Street Crescent (Graniet Landgoed) reported that on **3 May 2026** their intercom system cables at the entrance of their Crescent had been stolen. On 9 May 2026 the residents repaired the intercom system. On Sunday, 17 May 2026 the residents discovered that the cable had been cut again.(Corner Graniet and Fountain streets). Brinant detained and took the suspect into custody and handed him over to SAPS. **(Zone 4)**



On **8 May 2026**, a resident in v/d Merwe Avenue reported that 3 electricity boxes on the sidewalk had been vandalised and meters had been removed from the boxes. This was reported to Silverton SAPS



On **8 May 2026** at 18:40, a resident on the corner of Blom and President Street reported that their caretaker had been mugged with a gun outside their gate. Her cell phone has been taken by the suspects. **(Zone 3)**

On **9 May 2026** at 20:27 a resident in Brandwag Street reported that one of the houses in Brandwag Street reported that there was a fire in the roof of their house. Andre Fourie from the Fire department was on the scene. Andre reported that the fire is under control. **(Zone 4)**

On **14 May 2026** at 05h00 Extra Secure dispatched Sierra 1 to Conveyor Street in Silvertondale where strange activity was spotted. Upon arrival they noticed that there was a huge hole in the wall where the intruders gained access to one of the premises. After investigation they reported back that the 3 phase power cables had been stolen from the premises. **(Zone 8)**



On Saturday **16 May 2026** an attempted break-in was reported in Republic Street. Suspects fled from the scene. The suspects gained access from Basco Street. **(Zone 2)**

At approximately 08H28 on Saturday **16 May 2026** Extra Secure received a call form one of their clients in Moreletta Street. The

owner of the property had been assaulted by three individuals. who tried to flee from the scene. Extra Secure officers quickly caught them. SAPS Silverton were summoned to the scene and took the three suspects into custody the owner of the property opened a case.



Monday 18 May 2026 Extra Secure responded to an alarm of an individual pushing a shopping cart, Upon investigation they noticed the trolley belonged to Ultkyk. Sierra 1 confiscated the trolley and returned it to Ultkyk. **(Zone 4)**



On Tuesday 19 May 2026 at 13:11 residents reported a break-in in Jasmyn Avenue. **(Zone 5)**

On Thursday 21 May 2026 at 7:30 resident in van Wyk Street reported that their meter box on the sidewalk had been vandalised.

On Friday 22 May 2026 Mr Retief a loyal resident of Zone 4 asked his gardener Samuel. To clean a few streets around the Silverton High School. He started in Graniet Street from De Boulevard into Schuch Street around the corner in Brandwag all the way toward President Street turn left and **picked up all the rubbish the taxis were littering every day while parking and**

**washing their vehicles.** The route ended at corner President and De Boulevard Street. He picked up 5 black bags of rubbish.



On Tuesday 26 May 2026 a resident in Krige Street reported that a 19kg gas cylinder had been stolen out of his property. The suspects jumped the hall from and open stand in Krige Street. The suspects sold the gas bottle at Cash Crusaders at the Sasol garage. Their names and info are all available and known to the complaint of the gas bottle. (Zone 5)

## 8. RECIPE FOR THE MONTH

### **Cream of Tomato Soup (serves 4)**

1 Small onion, chopped  
10 ml Butter/margarine  
4 Large fresh tomatoes, remove skin and pips of tomato  
400g Tin whole tomatoes in tomato sauce  
15ml Tomato pasta  
5ml Sugar  
125ml Chicken stock

Sauté onion and butter until soft.

Add the fresh tomatoes, tinned tomatoes, tomato paste, sugar and chicken stock and simmer until soft. Liquidize the tomato mixture for a tomato puree.

In the meantime prepare the thin béchamel sauce. (White sauce).

### **Thin Béchamel Sauce (White Sauce)**

30ml Butter/margarine

30ml Flour

2,5ml Salt

White pepper to taste

500ml Milk /chicken stock (1/2 of each)

Ad tomato puree to white sauce and mix through.

Add the milk if soup is too thick and season to taste with salt and pepper.
