Several incidents of cable theft and vandalism of power boxes on the sidewalk have been reported by residents during the month of April 2026.



This long out standing water leak on the corner of Republic and President Street has been repaired during April 2025. During April 2026 a report of a burst pipe in Wouter Malan Avenue was also reported. The water of the burst pipe flowed into the property at the back of the of the property in Wouter Malan Avenue.

At 3;45 on Saturday 2nd May 2026 a senior member of the Silverton CPA member in Roberts street sent a voice note that a burglary was in progress on their property. Brinant, Extra Secure and Silverton SAPS were on the scene, fortunately nothing was taken from the property and the suspects fled the scene.

5. FEEDBACK FROM COT REGARDING THE TRUCKS THAT ARE USING ONIDA AVENUE

Feedback from Sydwell N.Mabase regarding complaint the trucks using Onida road to Silverton.

On **9 October 2025**, Marietjie v Deventer sent an email to COT regarding heavy duty delivery trucks using Onida Avenue to Silverton attempting to drive uphill which constantly causes breakdowns midway and which causes traffic disruptions in the area. Marietjie requested a site meeting with COT to determine a solution to the complaint and their proposal.

On **26 January 2026** Marietjie van Deventer sent an email to COT again and referred to conversations last year and meetings on site. Requested any feedback regarding the above mentioned topic.

On **4 February 2026**, Marietjie van Deventer sent an email to COT. Thank you very much for your effort and input in this regard. For so many years we have fought a losing battle.

Any indication when this will be implemented due to the serious stage of this issue.

On **4 May 2026** Marietjie sent an email to Marlise of COT.

Thank you again for the attachments regarding the road signs received. I refer to our last conversation 4 February 2026 regarding the above mentioned topic.

The situation is worsening on a daily basis affecting Onida Avenue as well as Fakkell Street, Silverton. GPS routes drivers of trucks through this dangerous situation. Inadequate road signs do not support the wrong decision of the driver until it is too late to undo the decision. Other motorists' lives are at stake here.

- i. SMS the word "Power" with your municipal account no to 0826120333. They will provide you with a reference number. The more residents send an SMS the quicker the problem will be solved. Alternatively, phone the municipality at the following number (012) 358-9999.
- ii. Report it to the CPA controller on duty, who will record it on the incident report of the day.

b. **Water Meters Tel no: (012) 358-9999)**

- i. When your water meter has been stolen, report it to the police and get a case no. Report it to the municipality with the address, nearest corner suburb, and your case number.
- ii. Report it to the CPA controller on duty who will also record the case number on the incident report of the day.

- i. When your dustbin has been stolen, report it to the police to be the case no. Report it to the municipality with the address and your case number.

9. RECIPE FOR THE MONTH

CREAM OF MUSHROOM SOUP (Serve 4)

1 Small onion, chopped
15ml Oil
1 Celery stalk, chopped
250g mushrooms

Sauté onion and celery in the oil until soft.
Wipe the mushrooms with a damp cloth and chop finely.
Add the mushrooms to the onion mix and sauté for 5 minutes.

Thin Béchamel Sauce (White Sauce)

30ml Butter/margarine
30ml Flour
2,5ml Salt
White pepper to taste
500ml Milk /chicken stock (1/2 of each)

In the meantime, prepare the thin béchamel sauce. Melt the butter over medium heat in a saucepan. Add the flour and keep mixing with a wooden spoon, creating a roux (sauce). Add the salt and pepper. Add the milk and stock mixture bit by bit

Add the mushroom mixture to white sauce and mix through. Add milk if the soup is too thick and season to taste with salt and pepper
