# 2. HERITAGE DAY 2025 MBS MEYERSPARK SANCTUARY

The Blue Bridge Area has been neglected for years, not only by the Friends Group but also by Tshwane.

2025 is a huge heritage day organized by Friends of Skuilkrans Kopje. This turned out to be a successful event, and people got together from all over Tshwane. As a matter of fact, every weekend, hikes are arranged for anyone to join.

Again, Silverton intervened in a cleanup, and is still involved in a stable maintenance program sponsored by the residents and businesses in the area. Thanks to everybody involved.

Also, the CPA is playing a huge role/part to ensure the safety of all the people visiting the Blue Bride area. Our cameras, fences, and cleanup management complete the circle of success.

#### 7. ACTION BY THE COMMUNITY

We are proud to share good news. Since 2019, we as the community have been battling to remove the squatters in Moreletta Street at the station (**Zone 5**). On 11 May 2025, Marietjie and Danie van Deventer emailed the Mayor and cc the Rekord as well as Media 24 and addressed all the areas neglected by Tshwane for months, and most of them for years.

Nevertheless, Tshwane ignored the email. No response at all. And then another email was sent to the Mayor on 9 September 2025 regarding the same issues, and they still ignored our emails.

And then on 11 September 2025, a **MIRACLE** happened. Tshwane did the final clean-up and removed all the squatters. We are grateful for their intervention. There are a few issues to sort out in Region 6. We discussed this and will work together to solve the problems in our area.

#### 8. HOW TO REPORT MUNICIPAL ISSUES:

- a. Power Failures (SMS: 082 6120 333/44676) External: (012358-2111
  - SMS the word "Power" with your municipal account no to 0826120333. They will provide you with a reference number. The more residents send an SMS the quicker the problem will be solved. Alternatively, phone the municipality at the following number (012) 358-9999.
  - Report it to the CPA controller on duty, who will record it on the incident report of the day.

#### b. Water Meters Tel no: (012) 358-9999)

 When your water meter has been stolen, report it to the police and get a case no. Report it to the municipality with the address, nearest corner suburb, and your case number.  Report it to the CPA controller on duty who will also record the case number on the incident report of the day.

- When your dustbin has been stolen, report it to the police to be the case no. Report it to the municipality with the address and your case number.

#### 10. MEASURING

To measure small quantities of dry ingredients accurately with a measuring cup/spoon: The measuring cup/spoon should always be filled level to the brim.

A Pinch of salt is the amount of salt that a person can hold between two fingers.

A 500g block of butter/margarine can be divided quickly and accurately in equal parts by cutting it with a knife as shown below.

NB: 500g butter/margarine (shortening) = 500ml 500ml =2 x 250g, =4 x 125g, =8 x 62.5g, =10 x 50g, =20 x 25g

# 11. RECIPES FOR THE MONTH

### OATMEAL BARS (Make 20 bars)

250 ml (125ml) Melted butter/margarine

125ml (60 ml) Brown Suger 2 (1) eggs

2,5ml (125ml) salt 25ml (15ml) Nutty Wheat

2.5ml (1.25ml) Baking powder 250ml (125ml) Cake flour

5ml (2.5ml) Vanilla essence/extract

500ml (250ml) uncooked raw oats

125ml (60ml) desiccated coconut

Preheat oven to 180°C and grease a Swiss roll/baking sheet In a medium mixing bowl, stir together the melted butter/margarine with the sugar.

Now, add eggs, baking powder, salt, vanilla extract /essence and mix well

Add the flours/coconut/oats and mix until well combined Spread the mixture in a baking sheet and bake at 180°C for 20-25 minutes until golden brown

Measurements in blue are for reducing the recipe
