- ii. Report it to the CPA controller on duty, who will record it on the incident report of the day.

- i. When your water meter has been stolen, report it to the police and get a case no. Report it to the municipality with the

address, nearest corner suburb, and your case number.

- ii. Report it to the CPA controller on duty who will also record the case number on the incident report of the day.

STAY ALERT. STAY IN CONTROL.

- BE AWARE**
Look around before and during your transaction. Be alert to suspicious people or activity.
- CHOOSE SAFE LOCATIONS**
Use ATMs in well-lit, busy areas such as shopping centres, petrol stations or inside banks.
- PROTECT YOUR PIN**
Cover the keypad when entering your PIN and avoid letting others see you.
- SECURE YOUR CARD & CASH**
Keep your card and cash out of sight immediately and avoid carrying money at the ATM.
- REPORT SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY**
Report suspicious devices, people or incidents to your bank and authorities immediately.
- DO NOT ACCEPT HELP**
Don't let anyone help you at the ATM or tell you something is wrong with the machine. They may try to distract you or steal your card or PIN.

EERSTE ELEKTRIESE STRAATLIGTE IN AFRIKA EN DIE SUIDELIKE HALFROND

Kimberley was op 2 September 1882 die eerste plek in Suid-Afrika, Afrika en die hele suidelike halfrond wat elektriese straatligte aangeskakel het.
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Sestien van hierdie nuwe lampe het die strate verlig. Die ligte is amptelik op 2 September 1882 aangeskakel (soms word 1 September ook genoem maar dit was 'n vroeë toetslopie).
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Die stelsel het van koolstofbooglampe gebruik gemaak aangedryf deur 'n klein stoomkragentrale.

Vroeë pogings was nie dadelik maklik nie. 'n Toets is reeds op 15 Februarie 1882 gedoen, maar slegs vier ligte het vir 'n kort rukkie gebrand voordat hulle doodgegaan het.

Tien September was die probleme uitsoorteer en kon die dorp spog met werkende elektriese ligte.

DIE KOOLSTOFBOOGLAMP

Die lig is deur 'n elektriese boog tussen twee koolstofstave geskep. Wanneer elektrisiteit daardeur beweeg, word die koolstof so warm dat dit 'n baie helder lig afgee.

Hierdie lampe is op hoë pale in die strate geplaas en was vir daardie tyd buitengewoon modern en indrukwekkend.

Kimberley het daarmee 'n wêreldprimeur op die gebied van openbare elektrisiteit behaal!



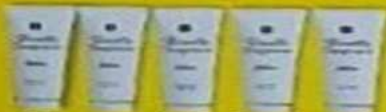
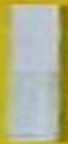
